Schneller Unveils AerScreen™, A Multi-Purpose Retractable Screen Laminate

Developed initially for Lufthansa's A340-600 wide body planes, AerScreen is designed to cover up galley areas during passenger boarding and deplaning, while displaying a dramatic brand image as part of an overall new interior decor.

AerScreen is a tough, flexible reinforced laminate that operates smoothly as a retractable screen in aircraft galley housings, is stain and abrasion-resistant, can be printed, embossed and perforated for a variety of visual effects.

In the Lufthansa application, AerScreen is perforated to show subtle backlighting when covering the galley area, while the front surface is spotlighted to showcase the Lufthansa brand image and complement the interior design.

AerScreen can be readily customized for other interior applications with or without perforations.

AerScreen complies with FAR25.853 vertical burn requirements, qualifying it for use on all aircraft fleets.
