

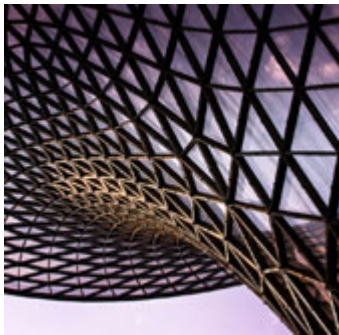

Schneller unveils its 2011 Collection of laminate and flooring designs at the Aircraft Interiors Expo

Hamburg, Germany: During an industry reception at the 2011 Aircraft Interiors Expo, Schneller introduced its first annual collection of Laminate and Non-Textile flooring designs to the aviation community. The 2011 collection on display was inspired by the universal design concept of nature and its influence on cultural creations.

As the Schneller design team explored the synergistic relationship between nature and culture they chose textures for their simplicity and natural appearance. The color palette of subtle blues and greens were inspired from hues found in nature while the neutral grays in the collection were chosen for their prominence in the man-made environment. In addition, our designers used this opportunity to experiment combining print methods to achieve sophisticated results - merging the precision of digital printing with pearlescent effects achieved through screen printing states Leo Esteve, Schneller's Creative Design Leader.

The collection on display is intended to provide inspiration and ideas for our customers. There is a variety of bold, elegant, and subtle decor to suit a multitude of design

The intent was to showcase a harmonized décor that could be used across the cabin interior – subtle designs for sidewall and seating applications, striking options for feature walls non-textile flooring options for lavatories and galleys all coordinated with upholstery and carpet graciously donated by Rohi and Anker respectively.

The launch of the collection is the latest in Schneller's efforts to expand its design offering. Late in 2010, they announced an expansive new Non-Textile flooring selection including new textures and prints.
